She is the third longest reigning monarch in British history. She endeared herself to the British public as a princess during World War II when she rolled up her sleeves and joined the war effort in the Women's Auxiliary Service. As soon as her father's health declined in 1951, Elizabeth began picking up many of her duties as the heiress apparent. Her reign is marked by milestones such as being the first British monarch to address a joint session of the US Congress and public turmoil, such as the divorce of her son Charles from Princess Diana. (Photo by Oli Scarff/Getty Images) The Duke of Edinburgh and the Queen Elizabeth II Consortium, born on 10 June 1921, are originally prince of the House of Schleswig-Holstein-Sonderburg-Glücksburgh-Glücksburgh, whose members are the royal home of Denmark and Norway, the Royal House of Greece. His father was Prince Andrew of Greece and Denmark, whose ancestors were Greek and Russian. Philip served in the Royal Navy during World War II. He received the title of His Royal Highness from George VI the day before he married Elizabeth on November 20, 1947. Because of Philips' surname, the couple's male children use the surname Mountbatten-Windsor. Princess Margaret, born August 21, 1930, was the second child of George VI and Elizabeth's younger sister. He founded The Prince's Trust, a charitable organization to help children, in 1976. He married Lady Diana Frances Spencer in 1981 at a wedding viewed by about 750 million worldwide. However, although the marriage gave the two princes- William and Harry-union became the stuff of tabloid fodder and the couple divorced in 1996. Charles later admits that he was involved in adultery with Camilla Parker Bowles, who he had known since 1970; Charles and Camilla were married in 2005; she became duchess of Cornwall.
